The April 30, 2020 Special Meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council for the purpose of considering proposed DCED feasibility study of eligibility of a Regional Police force was called to order by Council President, Scott Myers at 6:03 p.m. via Zoom during Stay at Home Orders during the COVID-19 pandemic.

It was established by response email from Lisa Kerle that there is no cost to Rimersburg Borough for the study, no obligation to participate in a Regional Police Force should one be established, and that Rimersburg Borough could, if desired, still hire the police force afterward. Roger made a motion to sign the letter of intent that Rimersburg Borough would participate in the DCED study which received a second from Pam. The motion passed by majority vote of all in favor with the exception of T. L. Stewart who voted against.
