Call to Order

The January 4, 2021 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott Myers at 7:08 p.m. with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark.

Persons to Be Heard

Frank reviewed the water report with Council. Allen Peters, Rider Rd. refuses to pay a shared leak amt., in shut off status for non-pmt. After discussion, general consensus was to follow policy and disconnect service without payment in full by the given deadline for fairness and consistency.

Chief Malnofsky reviewed the police report with Council and it was determined that at the end of the 2020 year, there are 74.75 additional unused hours. Unused hours from 2019 and 2020 total 225.73 available.

Scott asked if a presentation of some sort can be given at some point on the results of the DCED assessment for a Regional Police Force and what that means for participating municipalities moving forward. He stated that it is difficult for a Council Representative to translate. Chief answered in the affirmative.

The December 21, 2020 minutes were read and approved by a motion from Roger, second by Dan Stewart, and a unanimous vote.
