Call to Order

The June 21, 2021 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott Myers at 7:04 p.m. with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Scott.

Approval of Minutes

The June 7, 2021 minutes were read and approved by a motion from Roger Crick, second by Pam Curry, and a unanimous vote.

Public Safety:

Roger made a motion to adopt Resolution 02-2021 to participate in the Regional Police Department and appoint two representatives to it. Dan Stewart gave his motion a second and it received a unanimous vote in favor.

Building Committee: None

Streets Committee: General consensus was in favor of adding consideration of a no jake break ordinance to the next meeting's agenda.

New Business

Pam made motion to adopt Resolution 03-2021 as proposed to dispose of 5 boxes of cancelled checks, bank statements, water/sewer bills, and paid bills from years 2007-2011. These records are older than the required retention dates established by the PA Municipal Records Manual adopted by Rimersburg Borough Council Resolution 2-2016. T. L. Stewart gave her motion a second and it passed with a unanimous vote.

The draft of the letter to PennDOT regarding curbs, ramps, storm drains, etc. within PennDOT's next planned paving project through the Borough of Rimersburg in 2022-2023 was reviewed. The letter should be copied to PA Rep. Donna Oberlander, PA Senator Scott Hutchinson, the Senate Commission dealing with PA roadways, and the three Clarion County Commissioners. T. L. made a motion to send the letter, Roger gave a second, and all voted in favor.

The Rimersburg Chamber of Commerce is not holding the annual Car Cruise this 2021 year. The PA Police Association will participate with Scott Campbell in putting on the Car Cruise this year, however, with plans to take it over from Scott C. next year 2022. Scott Campbell asked the Borough to help this year with submission of the Highway Occupancy Permit (he will provide the insurance for the event), and Borough Maintenance will set out the barricades as usual. General consensus was in favor.
